Ahmedabad, November 20:

The All India Cooperative Bank Employees' Federation (AICBEF) today announced the postponement of its all-India strike call given for November 25 citing the present sensitive situation after the demonetisation. The coop bank employees were miffed with the Reserve Bank of India's decision of not allowing District Central Cooperative Banks (DCCBs) to accept demonetised currency notes of ₹ 500 and ₹ 1000.
